Subject: No License requirement for 85503 in Texas
Product Affected: Model 85503

Dear LiftMaster® Partner:

With the recent launch of LiftMaster Model No. 85503 (DC Battery Backup Belt Drive Wi-Fi® with Integrated Camera Garage Door Opener), we have received several questions asking if a special license is needed to install the LiftMaster camera or a LiftMaster door opener with camera capabilities in the State of Texas.

Texas law is clear that no license is required if the device is “not monitored by security personnel or a security service and does not send a signal to which law enforcement or emergency services respond.” See Texas Private Security Act, Sec, 1702.001 (1-a) for additional details.

The LiftMaster Model 85503 is designed to provide awareness to residents about their garage space, not to serve as part of an alarm system. Because the Garage Door Opener and Camera are neither monitored by security professionals nor wired to alert law enforcement officials, there is no current legal requirement for special license.
